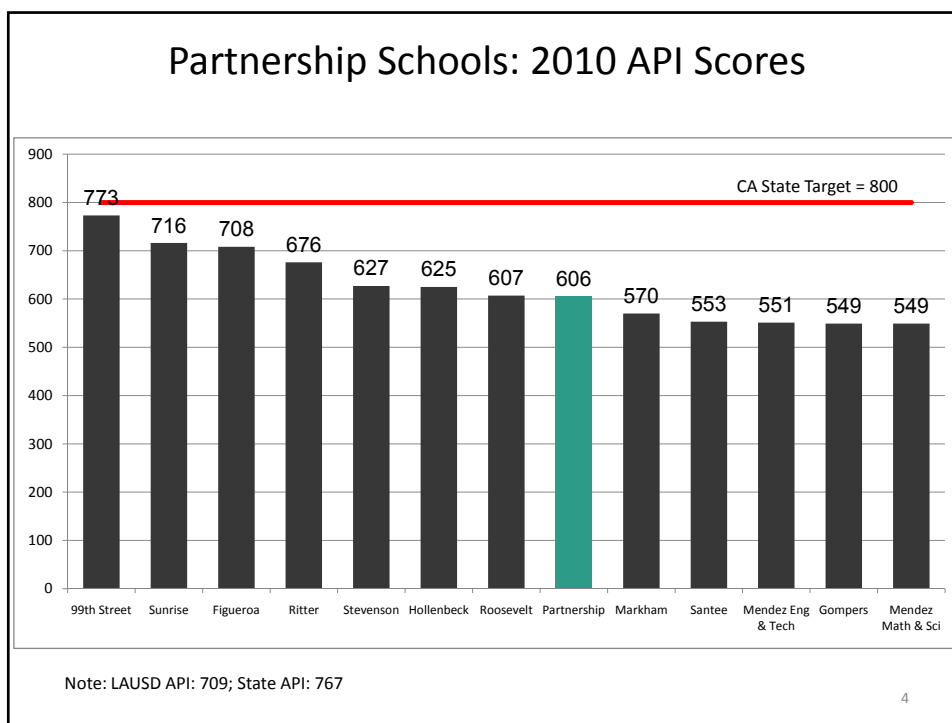
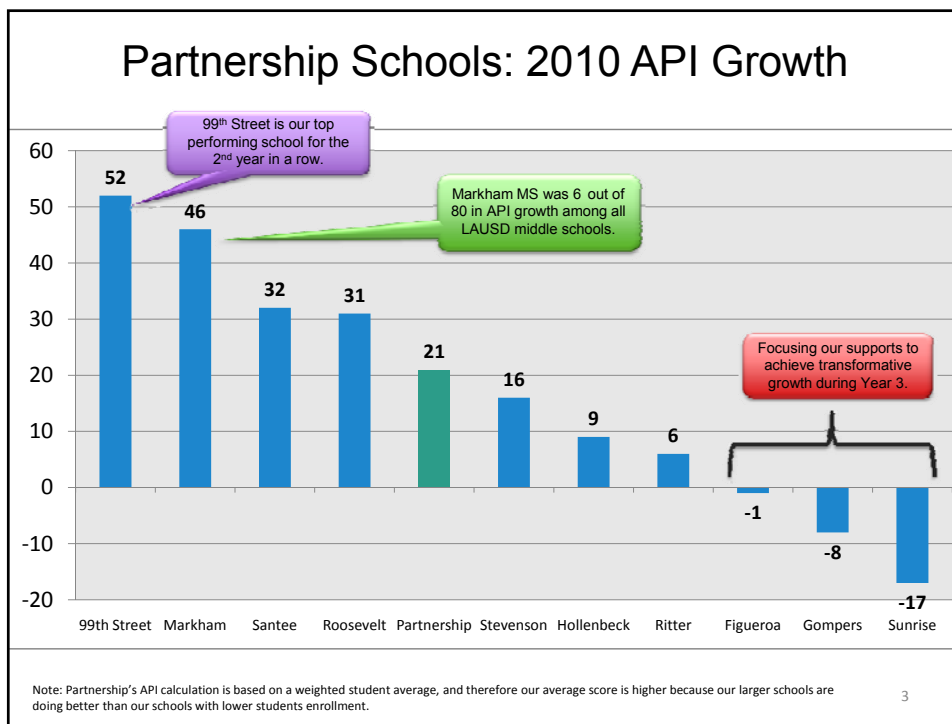

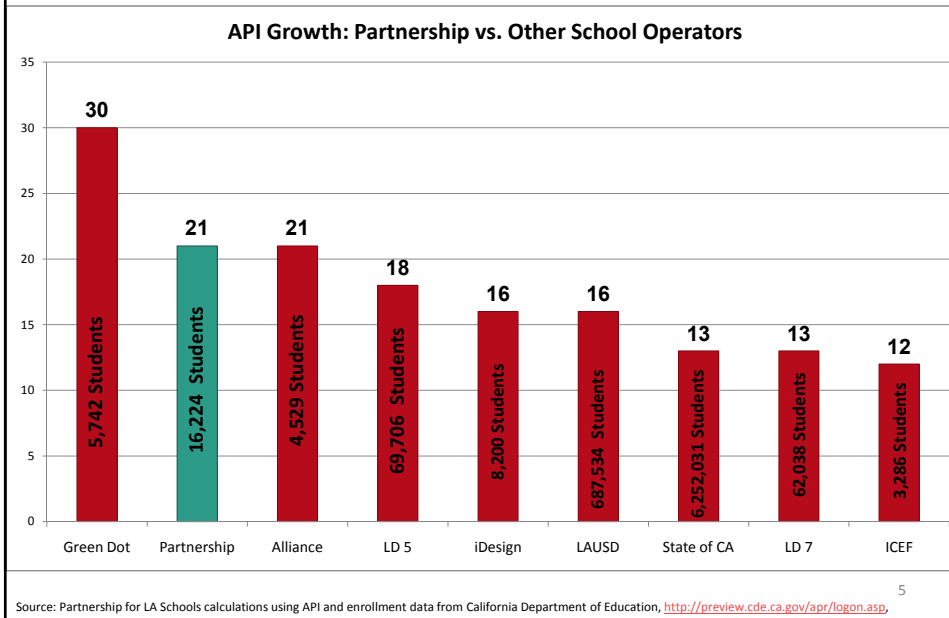
API Results Summary

- Overall API growth of Partnership Schools in 2009-2010 was greater than the API growth of the State, LAUSD and comparable schools (*and by a wider margin than the previous year*)
- Partnership is proud of the hard work and dedication of the students, teachers, administrators and other school staff who performed well in spite of many challenges
- The Partnership recognizes, however, that not all schools improved on the API and that collectively we did not deliver transformative API growth results in 2009-2010
- We believe deeply in the students and staff at Partnership Schools and are committed to accelerating achievement further in 2010-2011

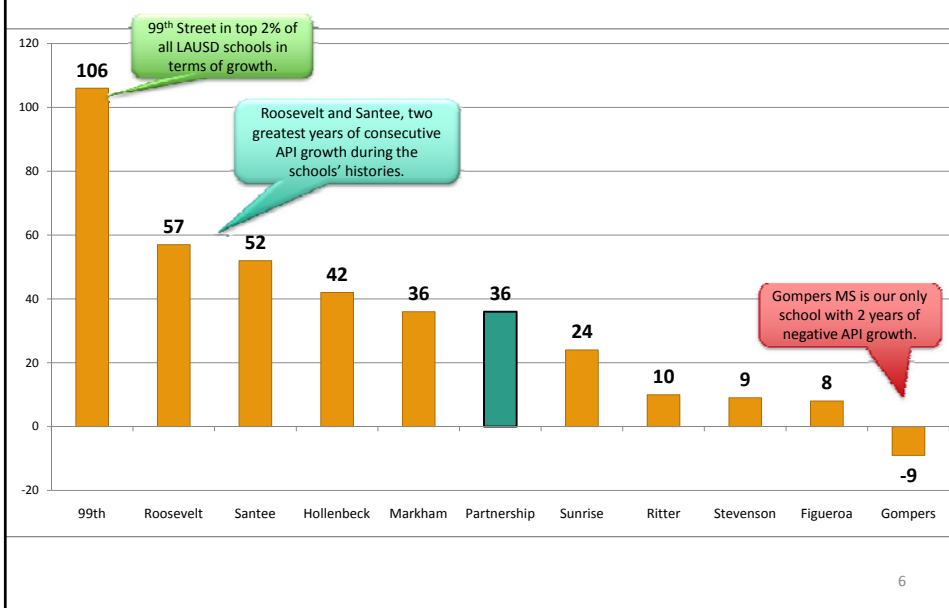

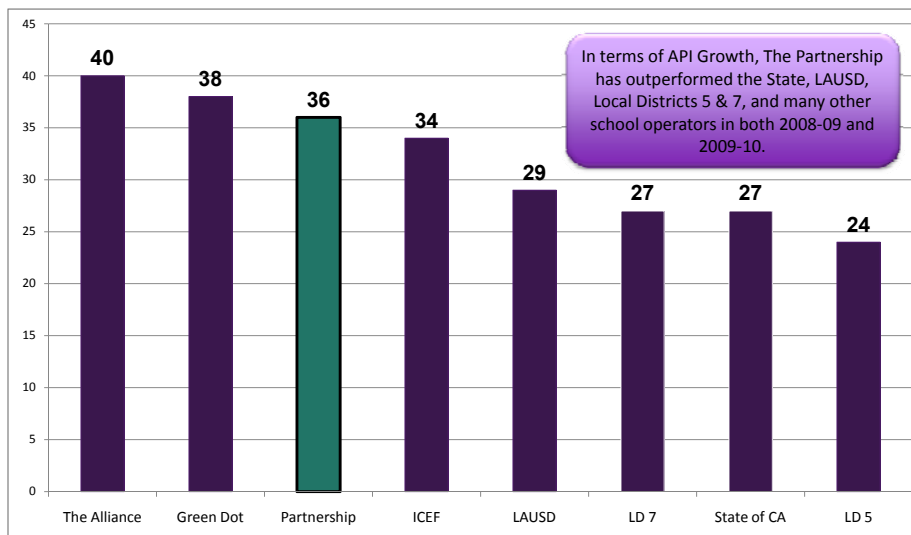
2010 API Growth: Partnership vs. other School Operators

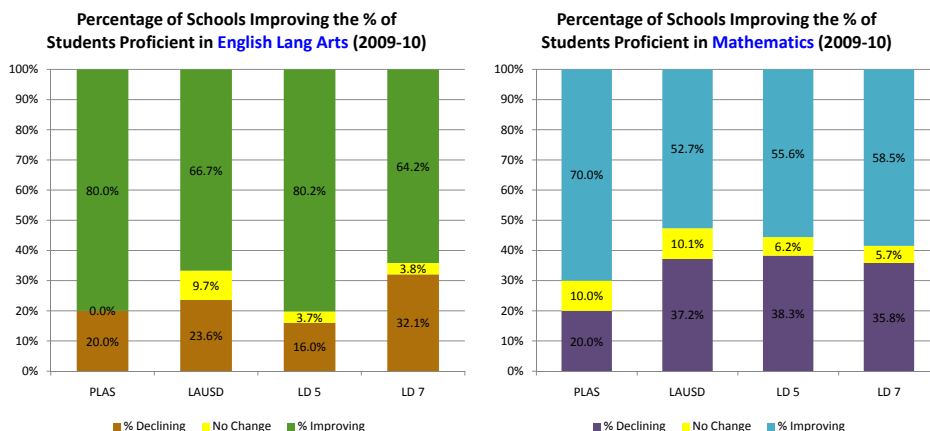

CST Results Summary

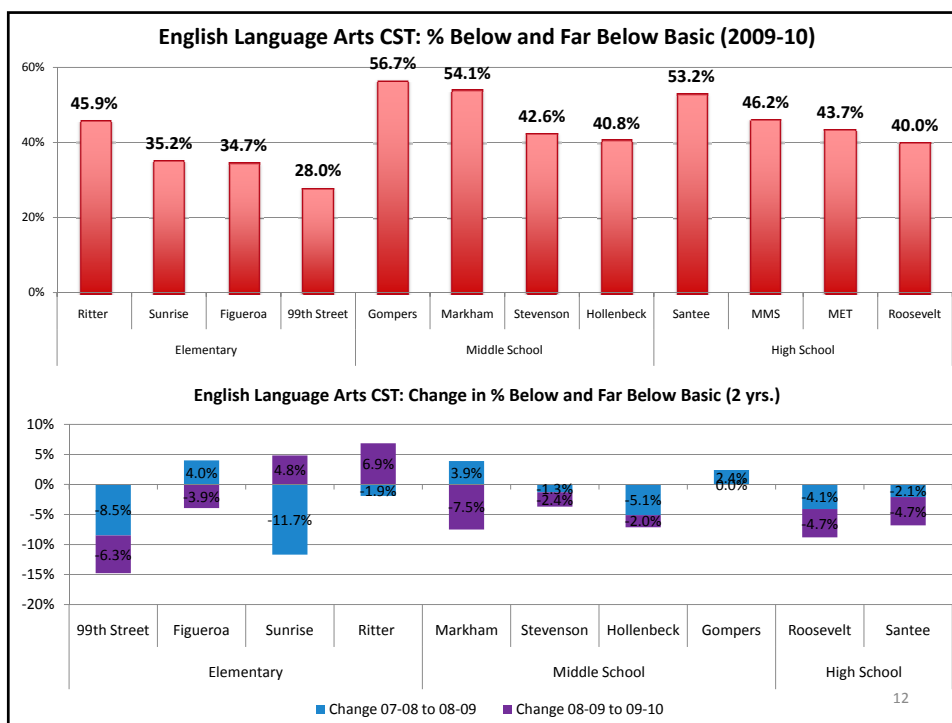
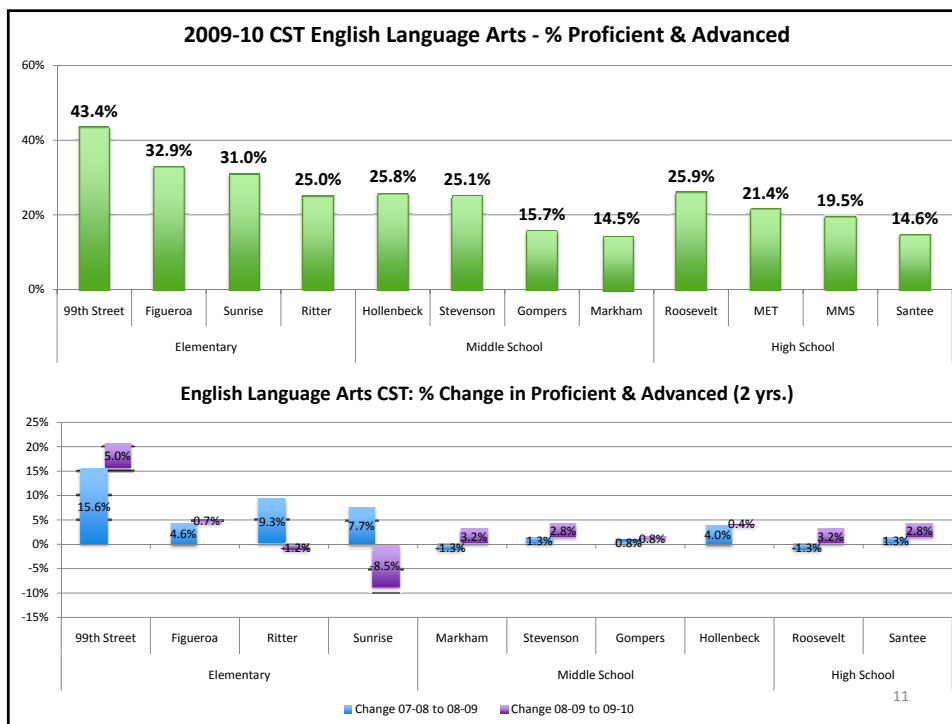
- **Summary of Increases in Proficiency**
 - 8 of 10 increased in English Language Arts
 - 7 of 10 increased in Mathematics
 - 6 of 10 increased in Science
 - 4 of 6 increased in History-Social Science
- **Partnership's Highest Performing Schools**
 - 99th Street Elementary - Increases in all three content areas
 - Markham Middle - Increases in all four content areas
 - Roosevelt HS - Increases in all four content areas
 - Santee EC - Increases in three of four content areas; slightly down in math
 - Stevenson Middle - Increases in three of four content areas; flat in History-Soc. Sci.
- **Partnership Schools that didn't improve achievement**
 - Figueroa Street - Decreases in two of three content areas; flat in ELA
 - Sunrise Elementary - Decreases in all three content areas
 - Gompers Middle – Flat or decreases in three of four content areas

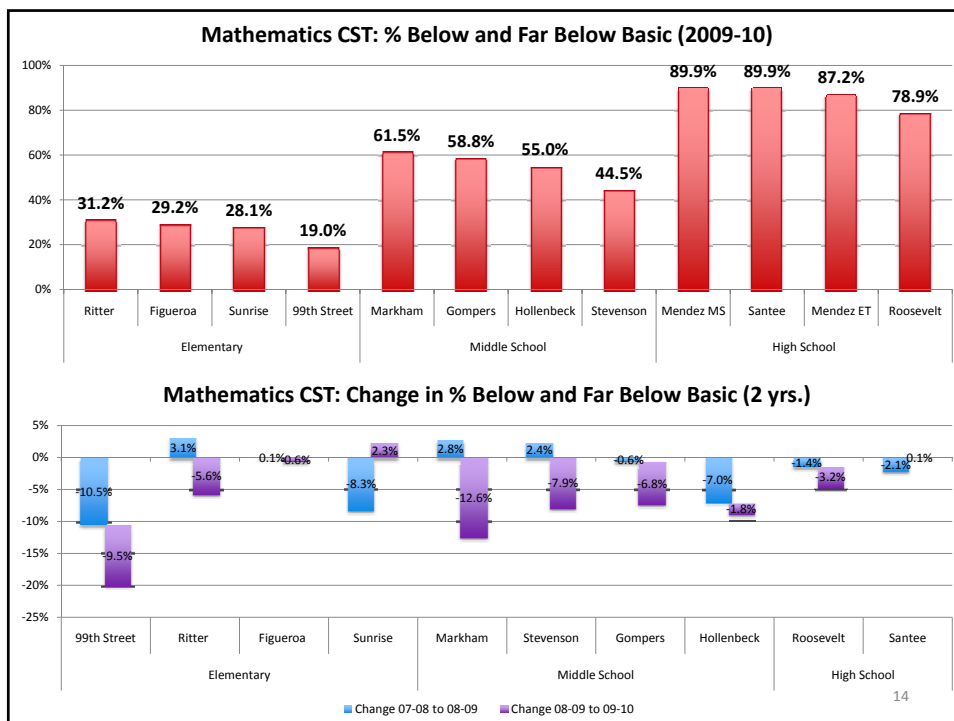
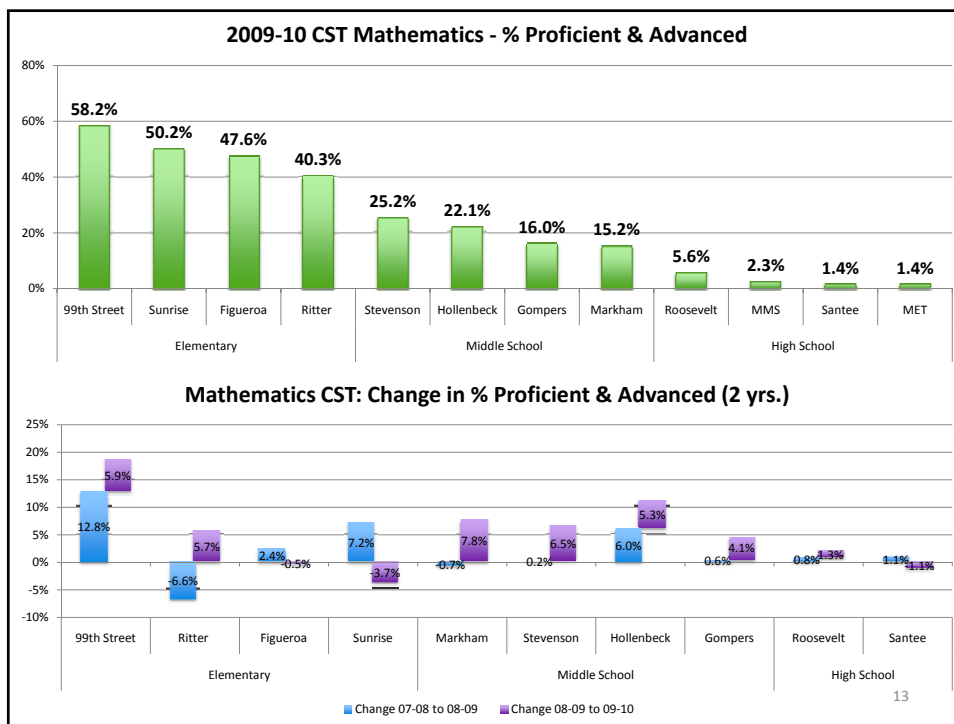

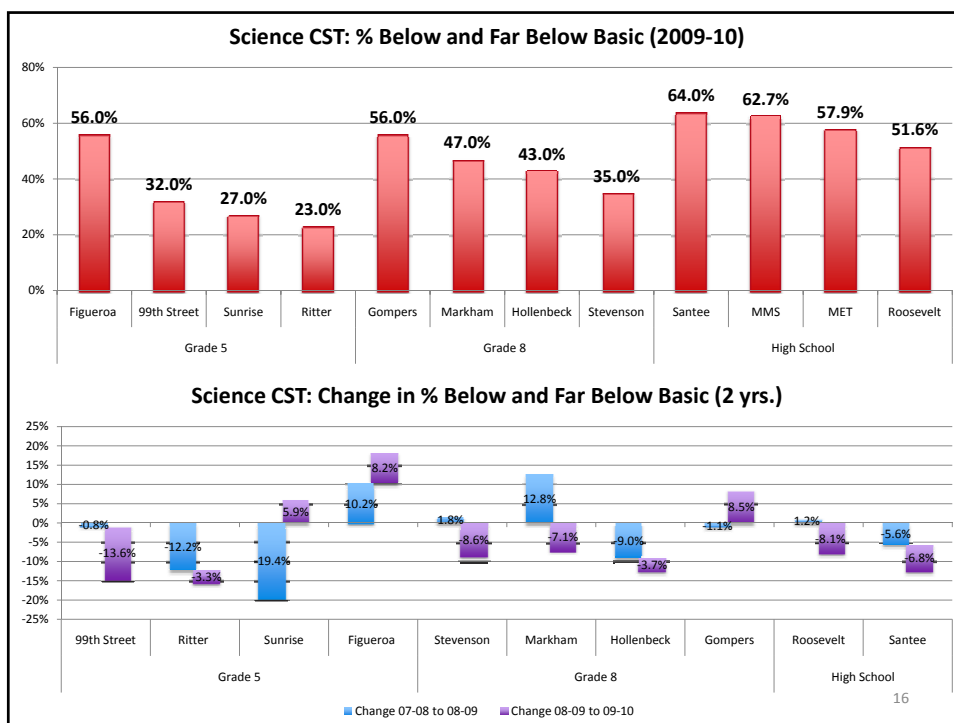
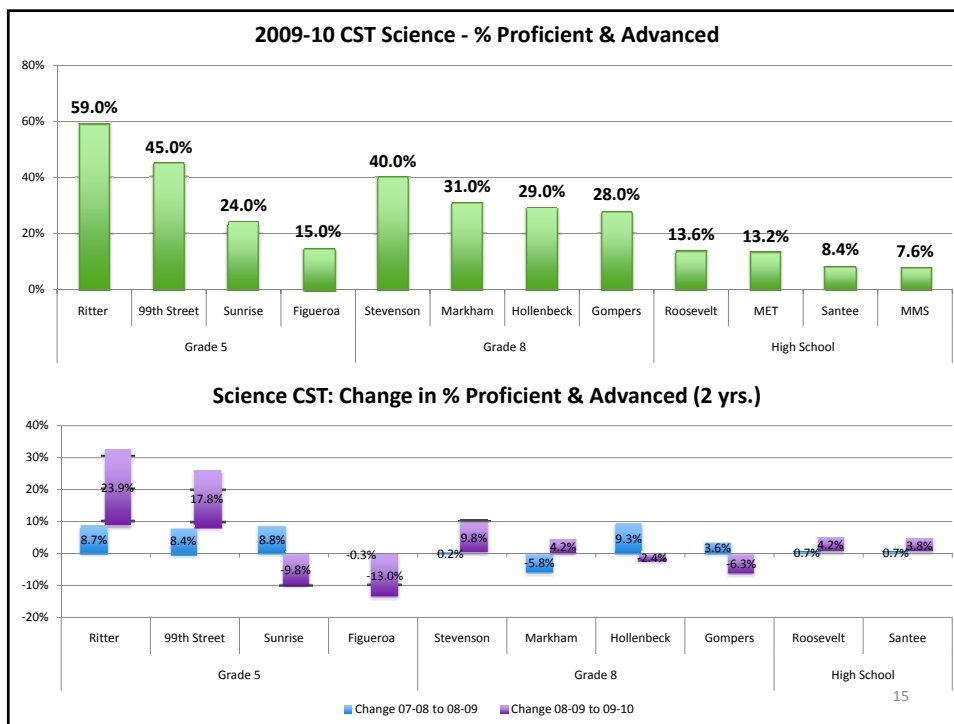
Percentage of Improving Schools (2009-10)

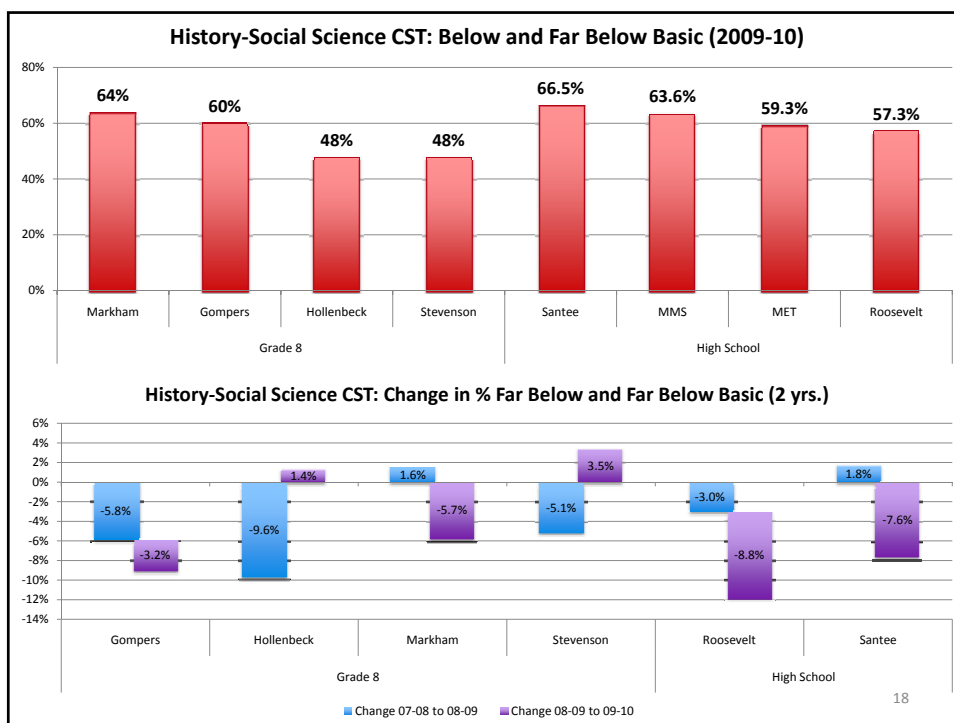
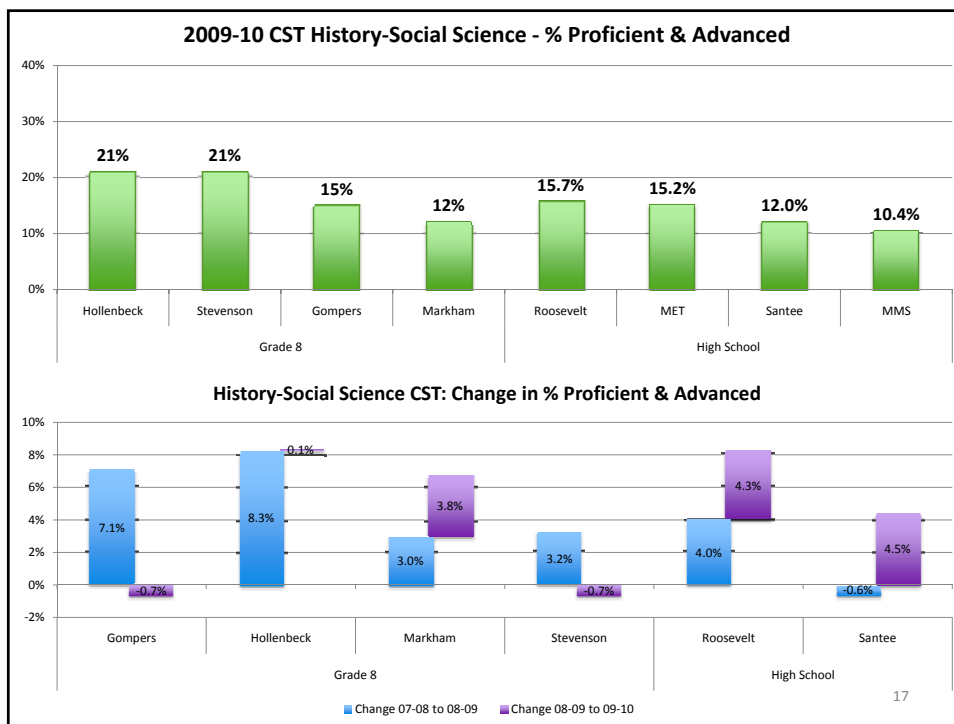

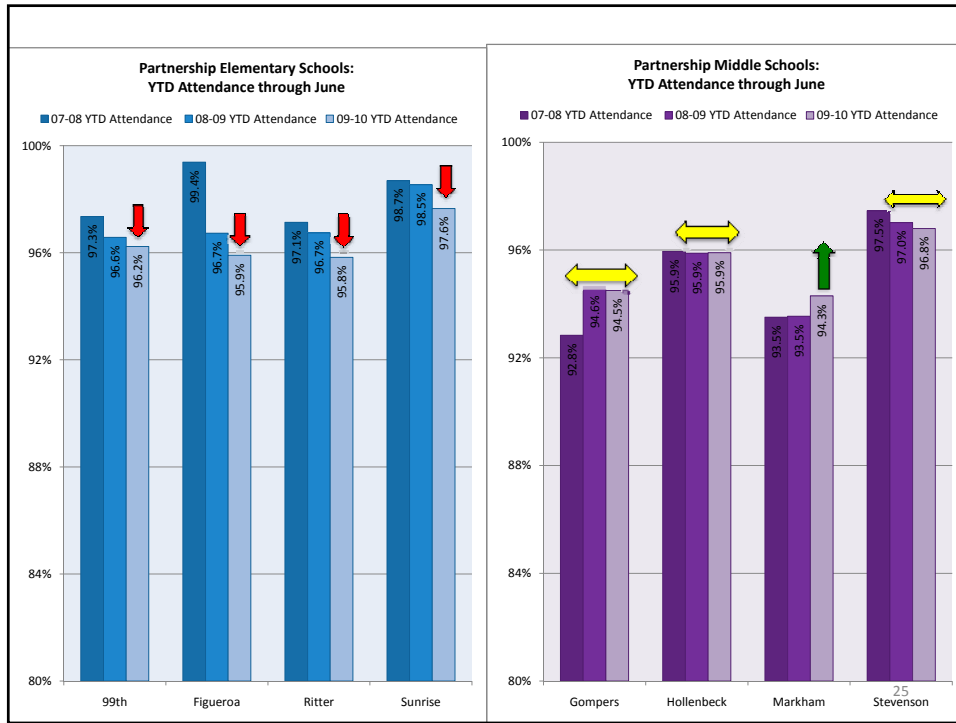
CASHEE Results Summary

- Santee has nearly doubled the percentage of 10th grade students achieving **proficiency** on CAHSEE ELA and Math over the last two years.
- Santee's growth in the percentage of 10th graders **passing** the CAHSEE on their first attempt is 4x the LAUSD 1-yr. average growth and 5x the LAUSD 2-yr. average growth.
- Roosevelt has made steady progress towards improving CAHSEE pass rates, outpacing the LAUSD and the comparable Local District 5 & 7 averages.
- Mendez Engineering & Technology and Mendez Math & Science both need to focus on improving 1st time CAHSEE pass rates during the 2010-11 school year.
