Learning Outcomes: Adaptive School Approach for Developing Collaborative Groups by Robert J. Garmston and Bruce M. Wellman

- Make authentic progress on team goals and challenges that support student achievement
- Develop individual and group capacities for effective dialogue to ensure effective collaboration and monitoring of school-wide efforts
- Achieve common understanding of concepts/ideas relevant to the team's work to support student learning
- Regard disagreement and conflict as a source of learning and transformation for the group
- Honor and utilize diversity within the group
- Access a wide repertoire of thinking and process skills

Work Products

- Depending on the team focus, some outcomes might include a year-long strategy for professional learning at your site, clear process and goals articulated for Small Schools Governance that can be distributed at the start of the year, etc.

Who are Instructional Leaders Teams?

- Instructional Team members must include the principal, UTLA rep and others at the advisement of the principal. Other individuals may include other formal leaders at your site (e.g. department chairs, SLC chairs, coordinators, coaches, instructional specialists), essentially these individuals serve as decision-makers for the school.

How many participants can each team send?

- Elementary Teams: 3-6
- Middle School Teams: 10-15
- High School Teams (Roosevelt HS and Santee EC): 20-25
- High School Teams (Mendez Math and Science, Mendez Engineering and Technology): 3-6

What happens if I would like to send more people?
